

Dr. Sheena Shukkur is serving for four years as Pro Vice-Chancellor of the Mahatma Gandhi University, Kerala. She officiated as Vice Chancellor in both MGU and NUALS for a brief period. Graduated from Vanderbilt University, with LLM she received an LLB from Calicut University, another LLM from CUSAT and PhD in Family Law from TNDALU. She was Assistant Professor in Law in the Kannur University, serving also Director and Head of the Department for several of those years there and was also faculty in the National Judicial Academy, Bhopal.

Dr. Shukkur is a Fulbright Vanderbilt Fellow in Clinical Legal Education.
